PREFACE

In order to provide an analysis of the employment situation in the organised sector of the economy Directorate General of Employment & Training (DGE & T) in the Ministry of Labour has been bringing out Quarterly Employment Reviews since 1950. The present review pertaining to the quarter ended 30th June, 2000 provides data on employment in the organised sector with a detailed breakup by States/U.Ts together with its distribution in Major Industry Divisions, both in the Public & Private Sectors. I hope the data and analysis presented in this review would be useful to the user agencies.

The data presented in this review have been collected and compiled under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme being implemented by the DGE&T through various State Governments and Union Territories. I take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks to all State Governments and U.T Administrations for their continued co-operation.

I also place on record my appreciation of the work done by Sh. A.K. Khanna, Dy Director and the officers & staff of EMI & Data Processing Units under overall guidance of Shri P.K. Ray, Director (LMI) in preparing and presenting this publication.

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SALIENT FEATURES

1. *The total number of establishments in the organised sector as on the 30th June, 2000 was 285.56 thousand (170.94 thousand in public sector and 114.62 thousand in private sector). An overall growth of establishments was recorded as 1.4 percent during March 2000 and June 2000.*
2. *As on the 30th June 2000 the total employment in the organised sector was estimated as 278.45 lakh as against 279.60 lakh at the end of March, 2000. Thus the total employment reflected a marginal decrease of 0.41 percent.*
3. *At the end of 30th June 2000 the public sector employed 192.34 lakh persons and the private sector employed 86.11 lakh persons. The negative growth of employment in both public and private sector was recorded as 0.41 and 0.40 percent respectively over the previous quarter.*
4. *Zone wise analysis of the growth of employment at the quarter ended June, 2000 over the quarter ended March, 2000 indicates highest decrease of 1.11 percent in the Central Zone followed by 1.05 percent decrease in the Eastern Zone, and 0.69 percent in Western Zone and 0.68 percent Northern Zone, Only the North-Eastern and Southern Zones recorded an increase of 2.71 and 0.10 percent respectively in employment.*
5. *Statewise analysis reflects that only the States of West Bengal and Himachal Pradesh recorded a decrease of more than 2 percent. Decrease in employment above 1 percent was conspicuously notable in the States of Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra. More than 3 percent growth in each case was observed in Daman & Diu and Assam and over 1 percent increase was noticed in Kerala and Orissa.*
6. *Analysis of the growth of employment by major industry divisions indicates that industry divisions viz. Mining & Quarrying construction registered highest decrease of 2.5 percent followed by 1.9 percent in Manufacturing, 1.0 percent in Transport, Storage & Communications 0.8 percent in Construction and 0.7 percent in Financing, Insurance, Real Estate & Business services and 0.6 percent in Wholesale & Retail trade and Restaurants & Hotels during the quarter ended June, 2000. The employment in all other industry divisions, however, registered marginal growth highest being 2.2 percent in Agriculture Hunting, Forestry and Fishing, Electricity Gas and Water 1.0 percent in June 2000 over March 2000.*
7. *A deeper analysis of growth of employment by various branches of the public sector reflects that Quasi Govt. (Central) and State Govt. were the only exception which recorded a negative growth of 2.37 and 0.25 respectively*

Local Bodies registered marginal growth of employment (0.49 percent) followed by Quasi Govt.(State) and Central Govt. recording nominal growth of 0.26 and 0.02 percent respectively..

- 8. As on the 30th June, 2000 a total number of 49.50 lakh women employees were engaged in the organised sector, out of which 28.59 lakh in the public sector and 20.91 lakh in the private sector. The growth of Women's employment over the previous quarter in the private sector alone was registered as 1.24 percent, and the private sector indicated an increase of 0.06 percent during the period under review. It is, however, an encouraging feature that Women employment reflected increase of 7.61 percent in North-Eastern zone followed by 1.15 percent in Eastern zone and 0.53 percent in central zone. Women employment in all other zones recorded marginal decrease over the previous quarter.*
- 9. An increase of more than 3 percent in women's employment was observed in a number of States (viz. Daman & Diu, Assam, Orissa and Kerala).*
- 10. Women's employment in all major industry divisions registered marginal decrease during the quarter ended June, 2000 over March, 2000 with the exception of four industry divisions which reflected an increase in employment highest being 6.3 percent in Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing followed by 2.0 percent in Electricity, Gas & Water, 1.5 percent in Transport, Storage & Communications and 0.3 percent in community Social & Personnel services.*

CHAPTER –I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 The present Employment Review relates to the quarter ended June, 2000. The data analysis contained in this review is based on the statistics collected under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme of the Directorate General of Employment & Training, Ministry of Labour, Government of India. The data/information on the level of employment is, however, collected only in respect of the organised sector of economy, which comprises of all establishments in the public sector and non-agricultural establishments employing 10 or more persons in the private sector. It is worth noting that whereas data from all the establishments in the public sector and those non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 25 or more persons are obtained statutorily under the provisions of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959, the data from non-agricultural establishments engaging 10 to 24 persons in the private sector are collected on a voluntary basis.

1.2 Collection of data under the EMI programme is resorted through an “Establishment Reporting System”. All the establishments are required, at quarterly intervals; to supply details about the number of persons they are employing, vacancies occurred and the type of persons who are found in short supply. The information relates only to ‘Employers’ and ‘Employees’. The term ‘Employers’ means owners, proprietors, managers, working partners or directors of the firms/companies. On the other hand, ‘Employees’ include all those persons whose wages or salaries are paid from the establishments but does not cover part-time employees and apprentices. The EMI programme precisely does not cover the following sectors:-

- Self employed or independent workers.
- Agricultural and allied operations in the private sector, except plantation establishments which are covered on a voluntary basis.
- Household establishments.
- Non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing less than 10 workers.
- Employment in Indian Missions/embassies abroad, Defence forces and those not covered due to administrative reasons and
- Smaller establishments employing 10-24 persons in the private sector in the metropolitan areas of Greater Mumbai and Calcutta are not covered due to practical difficulties.

1.3 As far as geographical coverage of EMI Programme is concerned, it is in operation in all States/Union Territories of the country except Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Lakshadweep. This programme has not been extended to these areas yet.

1.4 Besides above mentioned limitations of coverage the EMI programme has the following limitations:-

- i) The frame of establishments maintained at the Employment Exchanges is not comprehensive in certain cases, and
- ii) Employment in respect of the non-responding establishments is estimated on the basis of precise data available from previous quarters as was reported by such establishments.

1.5 The processing of data for the review is based on prescribed ER-I Returns, which were received from responding establishments for the quarter ended 30th June, 2000. The data might, however, undergo minor changes in future when employment data at three-digit disaggregation level of NIC for Annual Employment Review is finalized. In view of this, the data presented in this review may be treated as provisional. It may also be noted that totals in Tables/Annexure may not sometime tally due to rounding off.

CHAPTER-II

OVER-ALL EMPLOYMENT SITUATION IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR

ESTABLISHMENTS

2.1 The number of establishments in the organised sector had gone up to 285.56 thousand during the quarter ended June 2000. Out of these establishments, 170.94 thousand were in the public sector and remaining 114.62 thousand were in the private sector. The number of establishments at the end of June, 2000 by branches of public sector, and size of establishments in the private sector along with percentage changes over the previous quarter are presented in the following Table:

2.2 It can be observed from data in the above Table that total number of Establishments in the organised sector, which was 281.58 thousand during quarter ended March, 2000 increased to 285.56 thousand at the end of June, 2000 reflecting a growth of 1.4 percent. The growth of establishments was observed as 1.2 percent in the public sector and 1.7 percent in Private Sector as compared with the previous quarter.

2.3 Zone-wise/State-wise break up of establishments and employment therein as on the 30th June 2000 are presented in Annexure-I. The number of establishments in different States/Union Territories in various branches of public sector and by size of establishments in private sector is detailed in Annexure-II.

TOTAL EMPLOYMENT

2.4 The total employment in the 'Organised Sector' of the country as on 30th June, 2000 was estimated at 278.45 lakh as compared to 279.60 lakh at the end of March, 2000 indicating a marginal decrease of 0.41 percent. The sector-wise employment for the two quarters ended March, 2000 and June, 2000 along with relative percentage changes are shown in the following Table:

2.5 It will be observed from data in Table-2 above that there was a marginal decrease of 0.41 percent in employment in the public sector as employment decreased from 19313.7 thousand in March, 2000 to 19233.7 thousand in June, 2000 and the private sector also reflected a decrease of 0.40 percent in its employment being 8646.0 thousand on the 31st March, 2000 and 8611.0 thousand at the quarter ended June, 2000.

2.6 Zone-wise/State-wise distribution of employment as on the 30th June, 2000 by different branches in the public sector and by various sizes of establishments in the private sector is presented in Annexure-III.

EMPLOYMENT BY ZONES

2.7 The country has been divided into six zones according to the States Reorganisation Act, 1956. The Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands has, however, been kept outside the scheme of zonal classification embodied in the Act. The distribution of employment in various zones and separately in the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands for the quarter ended March, 2000 and June, 2000 are shown in Table-3 below:

***Note:** The data for Andaman & Nicobar Islands has been shown separately as it is outside the scheme of Zonal Classification embodied in the States Reorganisation Act, 1956.

2.8 Zone wise analysis of the growth of employment at the quarter ended June, 2000 over the quarter ended March, 2000 indicates highest decrease of 1.11 percent in the Central Zone followed by 1.05 percent in the Eastern Zone 0.69 percent in Western Zone and 0.68 percent in Northern Zone. Only the North Eastern and Southern Zone recorded a positive growth of 2.71 and 0.10 percent respectively as compared with the previous quarter.

EMPLOYMENT BY STATES/UNION TERRITORIES

2.9 Employment data in various States/Union Territories during the quarters ended March, 2000 and June, 2000 are given in Annexure –IV. Statewise analysis reflects that among major States only Daman & Diu and Assam reflected an increase of more than 3 percent in employment and above 1 percent increase was noticed in Kerala and Orissa over the previous quarter. The States of West Bengal, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan recorded a decrease of 1 percent and above in employment during the quarter ended June 2000.

EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRIES

2.10 Annexure-V presents details of employment by major Industry Divisions. Analysis of the growth of employment by major Industry Divisions indicates that major industry divisions registered a decrease of 2.5 percent in Mining & Quarrying (Div-1) 1.9 percent in Manufacturing (Div.2&3), 1.0 percent in Transport, Storage & Communications (Div-7), 0.8 percent in Construction (Div-5), 0.7 percent in Financing, Insurance, Real Estate & Business Services (Div-8) and 0.6 percent in whole sale and Retail Trade & Restaurants and Hotels respectively in employment during the quarter ended June, 2000. However, employment in the other Industry Divisions recorded a marginal growth, highest being 2.2 percent in Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry and Fishing (Div.-0) followed by 1.0 percent in Electricity Gas & Water (Div-4) and 0.4 percent in Community, Social & Personal Services (Div-9). Details about employment in States/Union Territories by Industry Divisions are given in Annexure-VI & VII separately for the public and private sector respectively for the quarter ended June 2000.

CHAPTER-III

EMPLOYMENT IN PUBLIC SECTOR

3.1 Employment in the public sector marginally decreased from 193.14 lakh at the end of March, 2000 to 192.34 lakh at the end of June, 2000 registering a negative growth of 0.41 percent in employment during the period under review.

EMPLOYMENT CLASSIFIED BY BRANCHES OF PUBLIC SECTOR

3.2 State-wise data on employment in the public sector by its various branches viz. Central Government, State Government, Quasi-Government (Central), Quasi-Government (State), and Local Bodies are given in Annexure-III. Summary details of employment are provided in the following Table:

Above data indicates that employment in all branches of public sector registered a nominal growth except in the case of Quasi Govt. (Central) and State Govt. wherein the employment decrease by 2.37 and 0.25 percent respectively. It is also relevant to note that within various branches of public sector local bodies reflected an increase of 0.49 percent in employment followed by Quasi Govt. (State) and Central Govt. reflecting increase of 0.26 percent and 0.02 percent respectively.

PUBLIC SECTOR EMPLOYMENT BY ZONES

3.3 A summary position of employment in the public sector classified by various zones in the country as on the 31st March 2000 and June 2000 and its change in terms of percentages are shown in Table-5 below.

As would be seen from the above data, employment in Public Sector recorded decreasing trends in all the Zones except in the case of North Eastern Zone and Southern Zone, which recorded nominal increase 0.14 percent and 0.11 percent respectively. However, the Eastern Zone registered highest decrease 1.07 percent followed by 0.62 percent Central Zone, 0.52 percent Northern Zone and 0.32 percent in Western Zone.

PUBLIC SECTOR EMPLOYMENT BY STATES/UNION TERRITORIES

3.4 Relative data on employment in various States for the quarters ended March 2000 and June 2000 for the public sector are presented in Annexure-IV. It could be observed from data therefrom that West-Bengal and Himachal Pradesh registered highest decrease of 3.3 percent and 2.5 percent respectively. Where as states like Daman & Diu registered highest increase in the Public Sector employment (4.9%) followed by Orissa (1.8%) as compared with previous quarter. Among all other states Public Sector employment shows a variation below 1 percent over previous quarter.

PUBLIC SECTOR EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRY DIVISIONS:

3.5 Annexure-V contains details of public sector employment classified by major Industry Divisions, wherefrom it would be observed that the public sector employment reflected a marginal growth of 0.6 percent in Electricity, Gas & Water (Div-4) and 0.4 percent in Community Social & Personal Services (Div-9). All other industry divisions registered a negative growth in employment, highest being 3.4 percent in Manufacturing (Div 2&3) followed by 2.8 percent in Mining & Quarrying (Div-1), 1.0 percent in Transport, Storage and Communication (Div-7), 0.9 percent in Construction (Div-5), 0.8 percent in Wholesale & Retail Trade & Restaurants and Hotels (Div-6) and 0.5 percent each in Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing (Div-0) and Financing, Insurance, Real Estate & Business Services (Div-8).

CHAPTER-IV

EMPLOYMENT IN PRIVATE SECTOR

4.1 Employment in the private sector as on the 30th June 2000 reflected a marginal decrease of 0.40 percent over the previous quarter i.e. March 2000. In absolute terms, employment in the private sector had gone down from 8646.0 thousand at the end of March 2000 to 8611.0 thousand at the end of June 2000.

EMPLOYMENT IN PRIVATE SECTOR BY SIZE GROUPS

4.2 Table-6 below reflects employment in the private sector by size of establishments. It would be seen therefrom that employment in the Act establishments employing 25 or more persons decreased by 0.39 percent and employment in the smaller establishments engaging 10-24 persons also registered an decrease of 0.56 percent over the previous quarter. The overall decrease in private sector employment was observed as 0.40 percent.

PRIVATE SECTOR EMPLOYMENT BY ZONES

4.3 An analysis of the private sector employment by six zones of the country can be made on the basis of data in Table-7 below. It shows that employment in the private sector recorded negative growth in all the zones except in the case of North-Eastern and Southern Zones, which recorded a positive growth of 6.76 and 0.10 percent respectively during March, 2000 and June, 2000.

Further, among other zones, the Central Zone recorded highest decrease of 3.32 percent in the private sector employment, which was followed by 1.23 percent in the Western Zone, 1.17 percent in the Northern Zone and 1.01 percent in the Eastern Zone.

PRIVATE SECTOR EMPLOYMENT BY STATES/UNION TERRITORIES

4.4 State wise distribution of private sector employment is contained in Annexure-IV. An analysis of private sector employment data for the quarter ended March, 2000 and June, 2000 would reveal that Daman & Diu registered highest growth of 14.3 percent followed by 7.1 in Assam, and 4.3 percent in Kerala. Only few selected States namely Orissa, Chandigarh, Nagaland recorded an increase of 1 percent and above in employment over March 2000. More than 3 percent negative growth was observed only in Uttar Pradesh. Among major States there were only few States namely Tamil Nadu, Rajasthan, Manipur, Maharashtra, Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal and Madhya Pradesh which reflected a decrease of more than 1 percent in private sector employment in June, 2000 over the quarter ended March, 2000.

PRIVATE SECTOR EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRY DIVISIONS:

4.5 Annexure-V contains details of private sector employment classified by major Industry Divisions wherefrom it would be observed that private sector employment as on 30th June, 2000 over March, 2000 recorded a negative growth of 1.5 percent in Financing, Insurance, Real Estate & Business Services (Div-8), 1.4 percent in Manufacturing (Div-2&3), 0.5 percent in wholesale & Retail Trade & Restaurants and Hotels (Div-6) and 0.1 percent in Transport, Storage & Communications (Div.-7). The highest increase was observed as 8.5 percent in Electricity Gas and Water (Div.-4) followed by 3.8 percent in Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing (Div-0), 0.6 percent in construction (Div-5), 0.5 percent in Mining & Quarrying (Div-1) and 0.4 percent in Community, Social & Personal Services (Div-9) as compared to the previous quarter.

CHAPTER -V

WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT

5.1 Women's employment in the organised sector of the economy at the end of the 30th June 2000 was estimated as 4950.0 thousand, which was 17.8 percent of the total organised sector employment. It is encouraging to note that percentage of women's employment to total has appreciably increased from 17.6 percent in March 2000 to 17.8 percent in June 2000. Out of the total women's employment (4950.0 thousand), 2858.6 thousand belonged to the public sector and the remaining 2091.4 thousand comprised that of the private sector. Sector-wise women's employment increased by 0.06 percent in the public sector and 1.24 percent in the Private Sector over the previous quarter. The estimates of women's employment in the public and private sectors for the quarters ended 31st March 2000 and June, 2000 and their respective percentage changes are given in Table-8 below.

5.2 It will be observed from data presented in Annexure-XII that among different branches of the public sector, the State Government engaged highest (say about 14.15 lakh) women employees, followed by Local Bodies (5.94 lakh), Quasi Government (Central) (3.42 lakh). Central Govt. and Quasi Govt. (State) engaged about 2.55 lakh and 2.54 lakh women employees respectively. In the private sector the larger sized Act establishments employing 25 or more employees engaged the maximum (18.78 lakh) women employees and the rest 2.13 lakh women were reportedly employed in the smaller-sized establishments (employing 10-24 workers).

WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT BY ZONES

5.3 A summary data on Women's employment classified by various zones in the country for the two quarters ended 31st March 2000 and June 2000 is presented in the Table-9 below:

5.4 Compared to the employment recorded during the previous quarter (i.e. quarter ended 31st March, 2000) Women's employment registered highest increase of 7.61 percent in the North-Eastern Zone followed by 1.15 percent in Eastern Zone and 0.53 percent in Central Zone as on 30th June, 2000. The Western, Northern and Southern Zones registered marginal decrease of 0.95 percent, 0.38 percent and 0.18 percent respectively in Women's Employment as compared to the quarter ended March 2000.

WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT BY STATES/UNION TERRITORIES

5.5 The Statewise distribution of women's employment is contained in Annexure VIII. It would be observed from data therefrom that Daman & Diu, Assam, Orissa and Kerala recorded an increase of more than 3 percent in women's employment as on 30th June, over 31st March, 2000. Above 1 percent increase was observed in the States of Chandigarh and Madhya Pradesh. The state of Tamil Nadu registered highest decrease of 3.2 percent in the case women's employment. Among other states only selected few States namely Maharashtra and Rajasthan recorded decrease of more than 1 percent in women's employment at the end of quarter June, 2000 over March, 2000.

WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT INDUSTRIES

5.6 The distribution of women employees in major Industry Divisions is presented in Annexure-IX. Data therefrom would reveal that excepting Five Industry Divisions which recorded a marginal decrease of 2.8 percent in Wholesale & Retail Trade & Restaurants and Hotels (Div-6) 2.2 percent in Mining & Quarrying (Div.-1), 1.1. Percent in Financing, Insurance, Real Estate & Business Services (Div-8). 1.0 percent in Manufacturing (Div-2&3) and 0.3 percent in construction (Div-5) all other Industry Divisions reflected appreciable growth in women's employment at the end of quarter ended June, 2000 compared the previous quarter. It was as high as 6.3 percent in Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry and Fishing (Div-0) followed by 2.0 percent in Electricity, Gas and Water (Div-4), 1.5 percent in Transport, storage & Communications (Div-7) and 0.3 percent in Community, Social & Personal Services (Div-9).
