Development & Maintenance of Web Based Portal and MIS for Monitoring & Evaluation of Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP)

1. DGE&T in the Ministry of Labour & Employment has received a Credit from International Development Association for Vocational Training Improvement Project [IDA Cr. No. 4319] for upgradation of existing 400 Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).

The Project is centrally coordinated, and would interalia establish a Management Information System (MIS) for about 2000 Government ITIs and central institutions covering all the States /UTs. The Project also envisages imparting training for using and maintaining the database at ITI, State/UT and central level.

2. DGE&T intends to engage a consulting firm to develop a dynamic web portal for the project and a web-based Management Information System (MIS) and Project Management Information System (PMIS). The consultant will develop the software for MIS and PMIS, and training manuals and train about 1000 people in the use of MIS and PMIS software. The expected date for development of MIS is July 2008. The developed MIS is to be managed for two years by the consultant before being handed over to DGE&T.

3. DGE&T now invites Expression of Interest (EoI) from the eligible interested firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. The eligible Consulting firm should have completed at least three solutions for State / Center Government in India that covers large services oriented portals and MIS or related information system implementation.

4. EoI from eligible consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified, to perform the services (brouchers, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skill among the staff etc) supported by the areas of experience of the organization with credentials, Quality accreditation details, for last three years.

5. Consultants will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers, May 2004 as amended in October 2006 based on Quality and Cost Based selection (QCBS).
